Top Discussion points:

- More policing would be an asset
- The RCMP are making arrests but the charges are not sticking and those people are being released, or they serve their time and end up back on the streets.
- In 2018 the RCMP received around 4,500 calls to service which equals about 700 files per member per year.
- The RCMP have 18 members total.
- Scrap Metal Buyers need to have more regulations to help prevent crimes.
- The MD and TOSL will follow up with the RMA and AUMA to find out regulations around scrap metal dealers.
- No matter the crime, everything should be reported to the RCMP so they can build accurate stats and crime maps.
- The Municipalities, RCMP, and businesses will work together to start a Crime Watch.


