Responsible Pet Owners Bylaw

1. No person shall own, keep or harbour any dog within the Town limits unless such dog is licensed as provided herein.
3. No person or persons shall keep or harbor more than two (2) dogs/cats aged six (6) months or more at one time in any house, shelter, room or place within the Town.

Part III-Responsibilities of Owner

1. No owner shall allow a dog to be at large
11. No person shall tease, torment, annoy, harm or willfully neglect any dog or domestic animal.

Penalties

- Failing to obtain a dog license \$ 50.00
- Allowing a dog to run at large \$100.00
- Allowing a dog to defecate on public or private property \$ 50.00
- At large biting, barking or chasing animals \$ 100.00
- No person shall tease, torment, annoy, harm, or willfully neglect a dog \$300.00

****Cases of neglect or serious harm to an animal including cats are investigated under the Animal Protection Act of Alberta and hold a fine up to \$10,000.00****
