

**PUBLIC HEARING

Town Council is giving consideration to amending Land Use Bylaw #22-2007.

The proposed Bylaw #02-2019 is to amend various sections of the Land Use Bylaw #22-2007 with respect to Commercial Districts regulations by:

- deleting the following definitions for “Amusement Arcade”, “Automotive Vehicle Rentals”, “Brewpub”, “Construction Workforce Facility”, “Convenience Store”, “Retail Stores” and “Night Club”;
- adding the following definitions “Offices Above Retail”, “Retail- Convenience”, “Retail- General”, Retail- Liquor”;
- Replacing the following definitions “Public Utility”, “Drinking Establishment”,
- Replacing Part 11 i.e. Commercial Districts.

If you or any group of citizens support or are opposed to the proposed amendments please deliver a letter to the Town Office no later than Thursday, February 28, 2019 or verbally make a presentation at the Public Hearing on Tuesday, March 5, 2019.
