Town Council is giving consideration to amending Land Use Bylaw #22-2007.

The amending bylaw proposes amendments to Part 1, General, Section 3 by adding a definition for Food Production. This amendment will also add Food Production as a discretionary use to the C1 – Downtown Commercial Mixed-Use District.

The purpose of this proposed amendment is to facilitate the addition of this use in a downtown business. As a discretionary use the Municipal Planning Commission must consider each application on a case by case, and site by site basis, in conjunction with an approved development. Thus, the Municipal Planning Commission may apply conditions and restrictions as and where they see fit and necessary.

If you or any group of citizens support or are opposed to the proposed amendments please deliver a letter to the Town Office no later than Thursday, April 2, 2020 or contact the Planning Department at 780-849-8004 to verbally make a presentation at the Public Hearing on Tuesday, April 7, 2020.
