

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BYLAW NO. 19-2007

This bylaw authorizes the Council of the Town of Slave Lake to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$20,000,000 for the purpose of the construction of the New Government Centre.

WHEREAS:

The Council of the Town of Slave Lake has decided to issue a bylaw pursuant to Section 258 of the *Municipal Government Act* to authorize the financing, undertaking and completion of a construction of the New Government Centre:

In order to complete the project it will be necessary for the Town of Slave Lake to borrow the sum of \$20,000,000.00, for a period not to exceed 20 years, from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority, by the issuance of debentures and on the terms and conditions referred to in this bylaw.

The estimated lifetime of the project financed under this bylaw is equal to, or in excess of 40 years.

The principal amount of the outstanding debt of the Town of Slave Lake at December 31, 2006 is \$4,524,813.24 and no part of the principal or interest is in arrears.

All required approvals for the project have been obtained and the project is in compliance with all *Acts* and *Regulations* of the Province of Alberta.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That for the purpose of constructing the New Government Centre the sum of Twenty Million DOLLARS (\$20,000,000.00) be borrowed from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution by way of debenture on the credit and security of the Town of Slave Lake at large, or which amount the full sum of \$20,000,000.00 is to be paid by the Town of Slave Lake at large.

2. The proper officers of the Town of Slave Lake are hereby authorized to issue debenture(s) on behalf of the Town of Slave Lake for the amount and purpose as authorized by this by-law, namely the New Government Centre.
3. The Town of Slave Lake shall repay the indebtedness according to the repayment structure in effect, namely semi-annual or annual equal payments of combined principal and interest installments not to exceed Twenty (20) years with the schedule attached and forming a part of each debenture.
4. The debenture shall bear interest during the currency of the debentures, the interest rate fixed from time to time by the Alberta Capital Finance Authority, per annum, payable semi-annually.
5. The Town of Slave Lake shall levy and raise in each year municipal taxes and/or collect lease revenues from the Province of Alberta sufficient to pay the indebtedness.
6. The indebtedness shall be contracted on the credit and security of the Town of Slave Lake.
7. The net amount borrowed under the by-law shall be applied only to the project specified by this by-law.
8. This by-law comes into force on the date it is passed.


