

**BYLAW #13-2004**

**TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE**

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING ALL TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE BYLAWS THAT REFERENCE "SECRETARY-TREASURER" BE CHANGED TO READ "CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER".

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, as amended, provides that the Chief Administrative Officer may in accordance with Section 209 of the Municipal Government Act, delegate any or all of the Chief Administrative Officer's duties and powers;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake enacts as follows:

1. That the position of "Secretary-Treasurer" be changed to read "Chief Administrative Officer or his designate" in all bylaws passed by the Town of Slave Lake.
2. By-Law #2-2002 is hereby repealed.
4. This By-Law shall take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
