

BYLAW #12-2020
TAX PENALTY BYLAW
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES ON UPAID TAXES.

This bylaw shall replace and repeal Bylaw #27-2015, and shall come into force and effect on January 1, 2020.

WHEREAS, Section 344 and 345 of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26(MGA), ~~as amended~~, Council may impose penalties on unpaid taxes at rates set out by bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act the Council of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That all taxes levied for any year shall be deemed to have been imposed and shall be deemed to have been due and payable on and from the first day of January to the current year, unless otherwise expressly directed to be levied.
2. That an amount of TWO PERCENT (2%) shall be added by way of a penalty on any current taxes remaining unpaid after thirty (30) days from the date of mailing the tax notices but not earlier than September 1st in any year.
3. That an amount of TWO PERCENT (2%) shall be added by way of a penalty on any current taxes remaining unpaid after thirty (30) days from the date of mailing the tax notices but not earlier than October 1st in any year.
4. That a penalty of TEN PERCENT (10%) shall be added to and shall form a part of any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31st of the year in which they were levied, and in each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.
5. The above penalty rates apply with respect to the license fees payable under the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 an amended, for mobile units.

That this Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of its Third and Final Reading.






