

**BYLAW # 17-2020
AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE**

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND LAND USE BY-LAW #22-2007.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, as amended, the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Section 42 (1) shall be amended by amending the following definition:

 “MERCHANDISING AID” means any device used for the display of merchandise and related advertising material which may contain a digital display or message. This definition also includes “Menu Boards” and “Pre-Sale Boards”.

2. That Section 44(2)(i) be amended by adding the following regulations:
 - (iv) if the merchandising aid is digital, it shall be placed such that it does not face or project into any residential area;

 - (v) a digital merchandising aid shall not interfere with traffic site lines or traffic safety.

That this Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of its Third and Final Reading.
