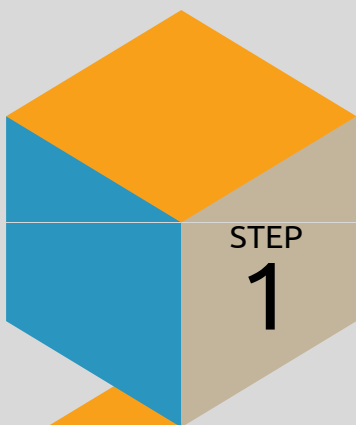


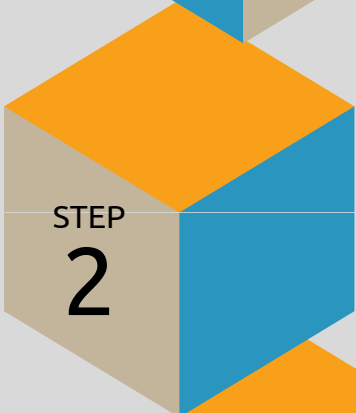


Rural Renewal Stream Process



Employer Submits Application

Employers with vacancies submit an application to the Town of Slave Lake Economic Development Department to join the Rural Renewal Program.



Review of Employer Application

The Town of Slave Lake will review applications and may conduct an interview with the employer to determine eligibility and participation in the program. Employers will be specifically requested to provide details on how they will support endorsed candidates' transition and integration into the community. If employers do not agree to take an active role in candidate integration, they **WILL NOT** be accepted into the program.



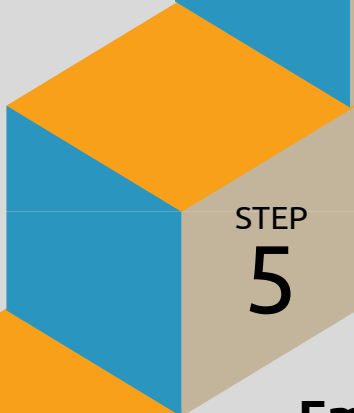
Job Vacancy Posted

The Town of Slave Lake posts the employer's vacancy to the Town of Slave Lake Rural Renewal Stream Job Posting Board.



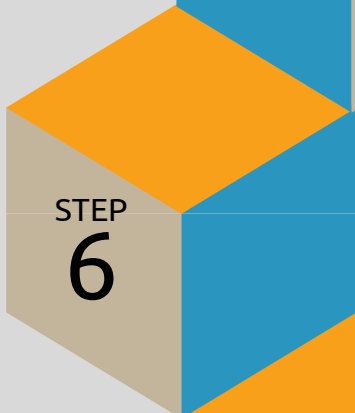
Candidates Apply for Position

Prospective candidates review the available Rural Renewal job postings and apply directly to the employer for positions they qualify for.



Employer Issues Job Offer

Employer issues a job offer to the candidate for full time, permanent work.



Employer Applies to Town for Letter of Endorsement

The Employer applies to the Town of Slave Lake for a Letter of Endorsement on behalf of the candidate.



Town Issues Endorsement Letter

The Town of Slave Lake issues an endorsement letter directly to the candidate for the Alberta Advantage Immigration Program.



Candidate Applies for Provincial Nomination

Candidate Added to Database

The Candidate is added to the Town of Slave Lake database for ongoing updates and support as they move through the immigration process and integrate into the community.
