BYLAW # 11 –2006

APPOINTMENT OF ASSESSOR

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF DESIGNATED OFFICER

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the provisions of section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties, and functions of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This bylaw shall be called the "Appointment of Assessor" bylaw.
2. Definition:

Section 284 (1) (d) of the Municipal Government Act (MGA) defines an assessor as a person who has the qualifications set out in the regulations and is appointed by a municipality to the position of designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor, under the MGA. Once a bylaw establishing the position of Assessor as a designated officer is passed, a specific individual may be appointed to the position in one of two ways;

- a. A council may appoint an individual to the position of Assessor by a resolution; or
- b. the Chief Administrative Officer, if given that authority by council, may appoint an individual to the position of Assessor.

In the case of a municipality receiving assessment services from a private firm, another municipality, or a regional services commission, the individual appointed as assessor should normally be the individual that handles the majority of the municipality's assessment roll, or his or her supervisor or manager.

2. That the position of Assessor be established to carry out the duties of an assessor as designated in the Municipal Government Act.
3. That this bylaw is effective upon the date of its third and final reading.
