

BY-LAW #12-1996

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO DELEGATE COUNCIL'S POWERS OF SUBDIVISION TIME EXTENSION.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 203 and 657 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1994, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter called the Council) may by by-law delegate its powers and, a Council may extend the one-year period for the applicant to submit to the subdivision authority the plan of subdivision for endorsement or the one-year period provided for an endorsed plan to be registered;


AND WHEREAS the Council has established by by-law the Subdivision Authority;

AND WHEREAS the Council does deem it desirable that subdivision time extension be delegated;

NOW THEREFORE the Council hereby enacts as follows:


1. That the Council delegates its powers of subdivision time extension to the Subdivision Authority.
2. That this by-law comes into effect upon the date of its third reading.


