

BY-LAW #32-1995

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH THE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 624 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter 24, 1995, a Council must by by-law provide for a Development Authority to exercise development powers and duties on behalf of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake (hereinafter called the Council) shall provide for a Development Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council, duly assembled, hereby enact as follows:

1. That the Development Authority for the municipality, notwithstanding Section 641 of the Municipal Government Act, shall be
 - (a) the Development Officer, or his/her delegated officer, and
 - (b) the Municipal Planning Commission, established by by-law of Council.
2. That this by-law comes into effect upon the date of October 31, 1995.




