

BY-LAW #8-1994

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ALBERTA VOCATIONAL COLLEGE - LESSER SLAVE LAKE TO OPERATE THE NORTHERN LIGHTS AQUATIC CENTRE (REFERRED TO AS AVC).

WHEREAS the Province of Alberta as represented by the Minister of Advanced Education and Career Development, through Alberta Vocational College - Lesser Slave Lake has constructed the Northern Lights Aquatic Centre and it opened at AVC on the Slave Lake campus due to the efforts of Alberta Public Works Supply and Services;

WHEREAS AVC wishes to have the benefit of the Towns' assistance in operating the Northern Lights Aquatic Centre; and

WHEREAS the President of AVC may authorize the public use of AVC facilities under Alberta Regulation 194/90 as amended for any purpose that benefits the community served by AVC;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Secretary Treasurer of the Town of Slave Lake be empowered to sign the Agreement with the Minister of Advanced Education and Career Development.
2. This By-Law shall come into force and continue from April 1, 1994, to and including March 31, 1997.
