

BY-LAW #2-1992

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BY-LAW #20-1985 providing for the imposition and collection of Off-site Levies on lands located within the Town of Slave Lake.


WHEREAS pursuant to Section 76 of the Planning Act, being Chapter P-9, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, (hereinafter called the Council) has passed By-Law #20-1985 providing for the imposition and collection of Off-site Levies on lands located within the Town and;

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable that By-Law #20-1985 be amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council hereby enacts as follows:


1. Section 2 is repealed and the following substituted:
"2. Commencing on January 01st, 1992, the amount of the Off-site Levy shall be \$5314.68 per gross acre on all lands which are to be developed or subdivided."
2. That this Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of Third Reading.


