TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, IN RIGHT ALBERTA, REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS, Section 90 of the Water Resources Act provides that the Minister of Environment may enter into an agreement with a Local Authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, allows a Local Authority to enter into agreements with other Governments; and

WHEREAS, the Minister of Environment and Town of Slave Lake are desirous of undertaking the following work:

THAT the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Slave Lake be empowered to sign the agreement with the Minister of Environment.


THAT this Bylaw comes into force and effect on the final day of passing thereof.
