AREA STRUCTURE PLAN


WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Town of Slave

hereby enacts as follows;


1. The Town of Slave Lake Southwest Area Structure



SCHEDULE "A"

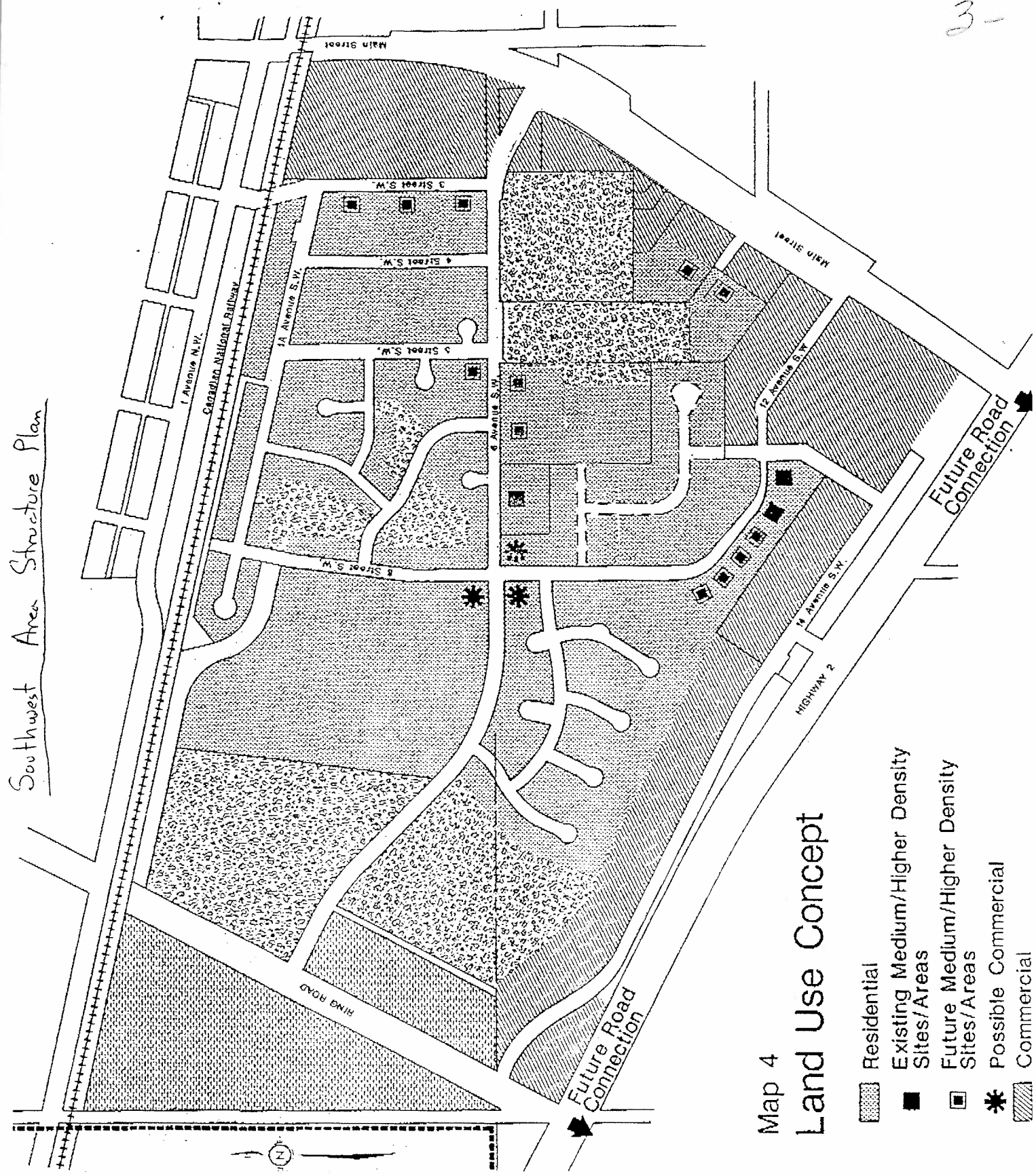
Chapter 3.0 is amended.....

1. Section 3.4 is amended by striking out it's heading "Parks and Open Space" and substituting the heading "Parks, Open Space and Community Uses" and by adding the following paragraph to the end of the Section:

"The Area Structure Plan sets aside several sites on 6th Avenue S.W., near Main Street, for community use. The existing arena and curling rink, as well as a day care centre, is developed on a Town owned parcel. The Athabasca Health Unit will develop an office facility just west of the day care centre. Slave Lake Roman Catholic Separate School District will construct a school building to the Southwest of the health unit.
