

BY-LAW #40-1991

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, IN THE RIGHT OF ALBERTA, REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF THE ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS the Town of Slave Lake is the registered owner of the following lands:

- N.E. 31-72-5-W5M;

AND WHEREAS the Lands were once used as a sewage lagoon;

AND WHEREAS the Lands have been reclaimed by the Minister at the request of the Town of Slave Lake;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Slave Lake and the Minister agree that as a result of the Lands' prior usage, the Lands may now be unstable for certain purposes and therefore the Town of Slave Lake and Minister agree that certain investigations should be conducted on the Lands by the Town of Slave Lake and his successors in title should a change in use of the Land be proposed;


NOW THEREFORE, Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, authorizes Town Council to enter into an agreement with the Province of Alberta and,

THAT the Mayor and the Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Slave Lake are hereby empowered to execute an agreement according to Schedule 1 as attached.

THAT this Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of it's Third Reading.


