

BY-LAW #2-1990

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
WITH THE MINISTER OF MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS TO CONTRIBUTE
\$45,000.00 TOWARDS THE AQUATIC CENTRE.

WHEREAS Her Majesty the Queen in the right of the Province of Alberta, through the Minister of Public Works, Supply & Services and through the Minister of Advanced Education, owns and operates Alberta Vocational Centre - Lesser Slave Lake and has agreed to construct a building which will include a Leisure and Aquatic Centre (hereinafter referred to as "the Aquatic Centre") on the campus of Alberta Vocational Centre at Slave lake; and

WHEREAS the President of Alberta Vocational Centre (hereinafter referred to as the "President") has, through Alberta Regulations #347/84 as amended, been given authority to offer to the public and approved the use of Alberta Vocational Centre facilities and has the full authority and responsibility for the operation of the Aquatic Centre; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Slave Lake, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Minister of Municipal Affairs shall contribute the sum of FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$45,000.00) to the Alberta Vocational Centre - Aquatic Centre - Town of Slave Lake at completion of the project.
2. The said contribution shall form part of holdback and be considered as final payment to the Contractor.
3. Residents of the Improvement District No. 17 East service area, will enjoy the same terms and conditions applicable to residents of the Town of Slave Lake.
