

BY-LAW #3-1990

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND LAND USE BY-LAW #20-1989.


WHEREAS pursuant to Section 68 (1) of the Planning Act, being Chapter P-9 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980 the Council of the Town of Slave Lake in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter called the Council) has passed Land Use By-Law #20-1989 as amended and;

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable that By-Law #20-1989 be amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council hereby enacts as follows:


1. That the Land Use District Map be amended as shown in the attached sketch plan marked Schedule "A" and forming part of this By-Law, by redesignating as follows: commencing at a point 29 m west of the intersection of the north boundary of Section 20-72-5-W5th and the south boundary of Highway #2, thence westerly at a 45° angle a distance of 219.2 m, thence north westerly a distance of 300 m parallel to said Highway #2 boundary, thence northerly at a 45° angle to the south boundary of Highway #2, thence easterly along the south boundary of Highway #2 to the point of commencement from UR - Urban Reserve to M1 - Light Industrial District.
2. That "Weigh Scales & Accessory Uses" be added to Discretionary Use; and
3. That a minimum parcel size in M1 - Light Industrial District be established at 800 m² (8610 sq. ft.) from 1860 m² (20,000 sq. ft.) and in M2 - General Industrial District, that the minimum parcel size be 1860 m² (20,000 sq. ft.) from 450 m².
4. That this By-law comes into effect upon the date of it's Third Reading.






