A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, IN THE RIGHT OF ALBERTA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION AND UTILITIES.

WHEREAS the Town has proposed the construction of the service road to the Slave Lake Hospital hereafter referred to as the "Road".

WHEREAS under Section 21 of the Public Highways Development Act, the Minister may enter into an Agreement with an urban municipality for the construction of any streets or roads.




NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake in Council assembled enacts as follows:


The By-Law will take effect upon third reading.


