

BY-LAW #8-1990  
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION AND UTILITIES REGARDING STREETS ASSISTANCE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Province desires to transfer funds to the Town of Slave Lake for Streets Assistance Grants in accordance with a letter from the Minister of Transportation and Utilities; and

WHEREAS, under Section 21 of the Public Highways Development Act, the Province may enter into an Agreement with an urban Municipality for the construction of any street or road; and


WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Utilities Grant Regulation, being Alberta Regulation 317/86, the Minister is authorized to make grants and to enter into an agreement with respect to any matter relating to the payment of a grant;


NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake in Council assembled enacts as follows:

That the Mayor and Secretary Treasurer of the Town of Slave Lake be empowered to sign the agreement with the Minister of Transportation and Utilities.

This By Law shall come into force and effect on the final day of passing thereof.


