

BY LAW #17-1990

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BY LAW #5-1975 BEING A BY LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVYING AND COLLECTING OF SERVICE CHARGES, TOLLS AND PENALTIES, OF THE WATER SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AND THE SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to amend Schedule "A" of the by law of the Town of Slave Lake in the Province of Alberta which provides for the levying and collection of service charges, tolls and penalties of the water supply and distribution system and of the sewage collection system:


NOWTHEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake in the Province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby enact:

1. That Schedule "A" be amended by addition of the following clauses:

- (a) Sanitary sewer disposal fees for customers within Town boundaries - \$20.00; added directly to the utility bill.
- (b) Sanitary sewer disposal fees for customers outside Town boundaries - \$40.00; invoiced to hauler.
- (c) The Town requires hauler to provide name and address of all sanitary sewer truckloads originating in Town. Failure to deliver this at time of disposal will result in load being deemed from "Outside Town Boundaries".

2. That this By Law shall take effect on the date of final reading.






