IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BY LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING AND CONTROL OF ANY BUSINESS
WITHIN THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE.

WHEREAS it is provided in and by the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutory of Alberta, 1980 and Amendments thereto, that the Council may licence and control all business within the Town of Slave Lake including the manner of operation, the nature of the operation and the location thereof, and may licence any or all such businesses whether or not the business has a business premises within the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Slave Lake duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw 10-1989 replaces Schedule "C" of Bylaw 35-1987.
2. Schedule "C" of Bylaw 35-1987 is hereby repealed.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect the day of third and final reading.

SCHEDULE "C"

FINE STRUCTURE FOR SECTION 12(B)

A. Violation of provision of this By Law by Resident Business

First Offense: Double the fee for a business license
(including the license fee).

B. All other provisions of this By Law by Non-resident
business and all Hawker/Peddlers

First Offense: Double the fee for a business licence
(including the license fee) plus \$100 for each day the
offense continues, exclusive of costs.
