

BY LAW NO.11-1989
OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

Being a By Law of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the Several Rates of Taxation for the year 1989.

WHEREAS the total requirements of the Town of Slave Lake as shown in the annual estimates, are as follows:

Municipal:	General	\$5,104,820.00
	Provincial Planning Fund Requisition	\$ 19,800.00
	Hospital Requisition	\$ 56,000.00
	Foundation Requisition (Heart River)	\$ 67,000.00
School:	School Foundation Program Requisition	\$ 210,000.00
	School Supplementary Requisition	\$ 917,700.00

AND WHEREAS the total assessment of land, buildings and improvements amounts to \$93,356,872.00 of which \$39,353,410.00 is commercial, and

WHEREAS the estimated revenue other than from taxation is \$3,455,015.00, and

WHEREAS the rates hereinafter set out are deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for municipal, school and other purposes, after making due allowance for the amount of taxes which may reasonably be expected to remain unpaid;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the Municipal Taxation Act, Chapter M-31, R.S.A. 1980, and amendments thereto, the council of the Town of Slave Lake in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

The Secretary Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all land, buildings and improvements as shown on the assessment and tax roll:
