

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING AND SELLING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 180 AND 183 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26 REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1980.

WHEREAS, the lands hereinafter described are no longer required for public travel, and;

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council of Slave Lake to have the lands herein closed, and;

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council of the Town of Slave Lake to pass a by law has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting upon the portion of the lane so proposed to be closed at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the by law, and;

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council of the Town of Slave Lake to pass a by law has been published in the Lakeside Leader May 24th and May 31st, 1989, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the by law, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the by law.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Slave Lake does hereby close the following described section of highway subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.

All that portion of First Street as shown on Plan 3086 RS lying to the north of the production westerly of the south boundary of Lot 2, Block 1, Plan 3086 RS.
Containing (0.23 acres) .093 ha
