

BY-LAW #29-1989

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF AN ADDENDUM OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HIGH PRAIRIE SCHOOL DIVISION FOR JOINT USE OF LANDS AND FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, Section 113, Chapter M-26 of the Municipal Government Act authorizes a municipality to make agreements with the board of trustees of a school district or division, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Slave Lake deems it advisable to authorize such agreements,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake, duly assembled enacts

1. That the Council of the Town of Slave Lake enter into the addendum as exhibit A (attached) and empowers the Mayor and Secretary Treasurer to execute the attached addendum of agreement between the Town and the High Prairie School Division relating to the Joint Use of facilities for recreational and cultural purposes.

2. That this By-Law shall be in effect on September 13, 1989.
