

BY LAW #14-1988

A BY LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO EXEMPT CHURCH OWNED LAND FROM TAXATION.

WHEREAS, Section 25 of the Municipal Taxation Act of Revised Statutes of Alberta R.S.A., 1980 authorizes a Council to pass By Law for the purpose of exempting Church lands in excess of one acre and

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of passing such a By Law

WHEREAS, religious bodies provide innumerable service to the community through family counselling and its varied other activities

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That a parcel of land held by or for the use of any religious body and on which is situated a building chiefly used for divine service, public worship or religious education shall be exempt from assessment a taxation for that portion which does not exceed three acres.
2. That the By Law shall take effect for the taxation year 1988 and shall remain in force for each succeeding year until amended on request.
