

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 180 AND 183 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26 REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1980.

WHEREAS, the lands hereinafter described are no longer required for public travel, and;

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council of Slave Lake to have the lands herein closed, and;

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council of the Town of Slave Lake to pass a by law has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting upon the portion of the lane so proposed to be closed at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the by law, and;

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council of the Town of Slave Lake to pass a by law has been published in the Scope Newspaper on July 5, 1988 and July 12, 1988, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the by law, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the by law.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Slave Lake does hereby close the following described section of highway subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.

All that portion of road as shown on Plan 946 E.O. in the E. 1/4 of Section 36, Township 72, Range 6, West of the Fifth Meridian which lies West of the production across said road of the Westerly curvilinear limit of the road as shown on Plan 469 L.Z., and East of a line and a curvilinear line drawn across said road parallel to and concentric with the Southwesterly limit of Road Plan 8821466, said line and curvilinear line being 30.00 metres perpendicularly and radially distant Northeasterly from said Southwesterly limit.
