

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

BY LAW #31-1988

A By Law of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, to rescind By Law #3-1977.

WHEREAS, By Law #3-1977 established a Board of Police Commissioners,

AND WHEREAS, the Police Act Chapter P-12.01 1988 has been amended to require Police Committees instead of Police Commissions for municipalities serviced by R.C.M.P.

WHEREAS, the Town of Slave Lake's Police Commission has not met regularly or fulfilled a meaningful role in overseeing a protective role in the community.

NOW THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Police Commission be disbanded.

By Law #3-1977 is hereby rescinded, effective on date of third reading.
