

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

BY LAW NO. 29-1987

A BY LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH HER MAJESTY, THE QUEEN, IN THE RIGHT OF ALBERTA PRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION AND UTILITIES.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council may pass a By Law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the Council and the Province or its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and


WHEREAS under the Utilities Grant Regulation the Minister of Transportation and Utilities may enter into an agreement with a local authority to provide for any work or undertaking; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Slave Lake has made application to the Minister of Transportation and Utilities under the Municipal Water Supply and Sewage Treatment Grant Program for financial assistance for a project relating to the installation of upgrading of Lift Station "C" and related work in the Town of Slave Lake;


NOW THEREFORE THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Secretary Treasurer of the Town of Slave Lake be and is hereby empowered to execute agreements similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A", between the said Town of Slave Lake and the Minister of Transportation and Utilities relating to the Alberta Municipal Water Supply and Sewage Treatment Grant Program.

THIS BY LAW GIVEN FIRST, SECOND, AND BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT THIRD READING, AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 18th DAY OF November, 1987.
