

BY-LAW NO. 6-1985  
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 180 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M 26, R.S.A. 1980.

WHEREAS, the lands hereinafter described are no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council to have the street closed; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council to pass a by-law has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting upon the portion of the street so proposed to be closed at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the by-law; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council to pass a by-law has been published in the Scope Newspaper on March 18, 1985 and on March 25, 1985, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the by-law; and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Slave Lake does hereby close the highway which appears as the cross-hatched area on the map attached as "Appendix A", subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations:

"Reserving thereout all mines and minerals."
