

BY-LAW NO. 7-1984  
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

---

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR AN AGREEMENT TO BE ENTERED INTO WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF ALBERTA, REPRESENTED HEREIN BY THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be of mutual benefit to the parties herein concerned, to jointly construct dykes on the Sawridge Creek for flood control and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980 and amendments hereto, Section 116 authorizes the passing of a by-law regulating the construction of dykes within a municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts:

1. That the Mayor and Town Manager be hereby authorized to sign an agreement between Her Majesty the Queen, in the right of the Province of Alberta, as represented by the Minister of Environment and the Town of Slave Lake to jointly construct dykes on the Sawridge Creek for Flood Control.
2. That the estimated labour cost is \$25,000.00 and is job WC224 file number 13415.
3. That the agreement will expire on March 31, 1985.
4. That this by-law shall be effective on the day of final passing thereof.

READ a first time this 23rd day of May 1984.
