

BY-LAW 10-1984
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH HER MAJESTY, THE QUEEN, IN THE RIGHT OF ALBERTA (REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION)

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council may pass a By-law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the Council and the Province or its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and


WHEREAS, under Section 21 of the Public Highways Development Act the Minister of Transportation may enter into an agreement with a local authority to provide for any work or undertakings; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake has made application to the Minister of Transportation under the Streets Assistance Program for financial assistance for a project relating to the reconstruction of 8th Avenue N.W.;

NOW THEREFORE the Town of Slave Lake Council duly assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


That the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Slave Lake be and are hereby empowered to execute agreements similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A", between the said Town and the Minister of Transportation relating to the Streets Assistance Program.


READ a first time this 27th day of June 1984.
