

BY-LAW NO. 19 - 1984

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE
OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSOR TO USE THE
1984 ASSESSMENT AND VALUATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY
AS SHOWN ON THE ASSESSMENT ROLL OF THE MUNICIPALITY
AS THE ASSESSMENT OR VALUATION OF THAT PROPERTY FOR
1985.


WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 28 of the Municipal Taxation Act, being Chapter M-31 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, and amendments thereto, the Council may by by-law, passed not later than the 30th day of November in any year, authorize the Assessor to use the assessment and valuation of certain property as shown on the assessment roll of the current year as the assessment or valuation of that property for the next following year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of Section 28 of the Municipal Taxation Act, as amended, DOES HEREBY ENACT as FOLLOWS:

1. That the municipal assessor is hereby authorized to use the assessment and valuation of all properties as shown on the assessment roll as the assessment or valuation of that property for the taxation year 1985 exception for:
 - a) Those properties required to be assessed and valued in accordance with Section 34 and 35 of the Municipal Taxation Act.
2. That this by-law shall come into effect upon the date of the final reading.

Read a first and second time and with unanimous consent of Council present read a third time this 9th day of January, 1985.
