

BYLAW NO. 5 - 1983

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR AN AGREEMENT TO BE INTERED INTO WITH THE ALBERTA RECREATION AND PARKS.


WHEREAS, it is deemed to be of mutual benefit to the parties herein concerned, to utilize jointly the nuisance grounds, located on LSD's 13 and 14 of Section Seventeen (17), Township Seventy Two (72), Range Five (5), West of the Fifth (5) Meridian, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Revised Status of Alberta, 1980 and amendments hereto, Section 199 (b), authorizes the passing of a by-law regulating and controlling the use of nuisance grounds owned or used by the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled enacts:

1. That the Mayor and Town Manager be hereby authorized to sign an agreement between Her Majesty the Queen, in the right of the Province of Alberta, as represented by Alberta Recreation and Parks and the Town of Slave Lake to jointly utilize the nuisance grounds for a term of five (5) years form the date thereof subject to renewal as set out in the agreement.
2. That this bylaw shall be effective on the day of final passing thereof.
