

BY-LAW NO. 2-1976

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 175 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER 246, R.S.A. 1970.

WHEREAS, the lands hereinafter described are no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council to have the road allowance closed; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council to pass a By-Law has been published in the Lakeside Leader on February 11, 1976 and on February 18, 1976, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the By-Law; and


WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the By-Law;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Slave Lake does hereby close the following described highway subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations:-

"The Westerly fourteen (14) feet of 3rd Street West lying between Road Plan No. 946E0 (3rd Avenue S.W.) and 1st. Avenue South as shown on Reg'd Plan 3046 N.Y..

Reserving Thereout All Mines and Minerals."

Read a first and second time this 11th day of February, 1976.


