

BYLAW NO. 14-1976
OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A Bylaw to authorize the Mayor and
Secretary to sign and execute on behalf
of the Town of Slave Lake a Franchise
Agreement with Alberta Power Limited
for the supply of electric energy to the
Town of Slave Lake.

WHEREAS Canadian Utilities, Limited received approval of
the Public Utilities Board of Alberta, per Order No. 19469, dated March 26,
1957, to supply electric light and power to the inhabitants of the Hamlet of
Slave Lake;

AND WHEREAS the Hamlet of Slave Lake was incorporated as
a Village January 1, 1961, and was incorporated as a Town (hereinafter called
"the Town") on July 27, 1965;

AND WHEREAS Canadian Utilities, Limited, assigned all of
its interest under the said Public Utilities Board No. 19469 to Alberta Power
Limited;

AND WHEREAS the Town and Alberta Power Limited desire
a continuation of the said electric light and power supply;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA:

1. THAT the Agreement, a copy of which is set forth in
Schedule "A" hereto annexed, be and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed
and approved, and the Mayor and Secretary of the Town are hereby authorized
to sign and execute the said Agreement for and on behalf of the Town and to
affix the Seal of the Town thereto.

2. THAT the said Agreement as set forth in the said Schedule "A" is hereby embodied in and made part of this Bylaw.

3. THAT application be made to the Public Utilities Board for its approval of the said Agreement.

The above Bylaw and the said Agreement, as part thereof, was read by the Council of the Town at a meeting of the Council held on the

27th day of October, 1976.
