

BY-LAW NO. 14-1975

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES
ON UNPAID TAXES.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Slave Lake deem it expedient to amend the Penalty structure authorized by By-Law No. 153 passed December 10th, 1969.

THEREFORE under the authority of and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Taxation Act, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake hereby enacts.

1. That all taxes levied for any year shall be deemed to have been imposed and shall be deemed to have been due and payable on and from the first day of January of the then current year, unless otherwise expressly directed to be levied.

2. That an amount of FOUR PERCENT (4%) shall be added by way of a penalty on any current taxes remaining unpaid after thirty (30) days from the date of mailing the tax notices but not earlier than July 1st in any year, and a further FOUR PERCENT (4%) shall be added by way of penalty on any current taxes remaining unpaid after the 1st day of October of the year for which they were levied.

3. That a penalty of ten per cent (10%) shall be added to and shall form a part of any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31 of the year in which they were levied, and in each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.

4. This by-law shall replace and repeal By-Law 153 and shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing.

Read a first and second time this 26th day of November, 1975.

Read a third time and finally passed this 26th day of November, 1975.
