

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO PROVIDE FOR THE
ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of this Council, it is deemed expedient and advisable to acquire lands hereinafter described to be used for the purpose of subdivision development and resale as needed.

The Council of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled and under the authority and subject to the provisions of Section 127, Subsection 7, of The Municipal Government Act enacts as follows:

- (1) THAT, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase or otherwise, that certain parcel of land more particular described as follows:

The south west quarter of Section Six (6) Township Seventy-Three (73) Range Five (5) West of the Fifth Meridian in the said Province containing One Hundred and Sixty (160) acres more or less. EXCEPTING THEREOUT

(A) All that Portion described as follows; ---- commencing at a point on the west boundary of the said quarter section, One Hundred and Forty-Four (144) feet northerly from the south west corner thereof; thence easterly and at right angles to the said west boundary Two Hundred and Eight and Seven Tenths (208.7) feet; thence northerly and parallel to the said west boundary Four Hundred and Seventeen and Four Tenths (417.4) feet; thence westerly and at right angles to the said west boundary; thence southerly along the said west boundary to the point of commencement, containing Two (2) acres more or less.

(B) Three and Fourty-Four Hundredths (3.44) acres more or less subdivided under Plan 192 K.S.

(C) Fifty-Seven Hundredths (0.57) of an acre more or less for road as shown on Road Plan 368 L.Z.

(D) Eleven (11) acres more or less subdivided under Plan 206 R.S.

(E) Seven and Fifty Two Hundredths (7.52) acres more or less subdivided under Plan 2507 R.S.

(F) Fourty One Hundredths (0.41) of an acre more or less subdivided under Plan 4515 R.S.

The land hereby described containing One Hundred and Thirty-Five and Six Hundredths (135.06) acres more or less.


