

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

BY-LAW 11-1971

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE  
TO IMPLEMENT THE FLUORIDATION OF WATER IN  
THE TOWN WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS the Council was asked to hold a plebiscite during October, 1971, so the people might express their opinion on fluoridation of the water supply.

AND WHEREAS the Council under Section 122 of the Municipal Government Act being Chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta decided to hold such plebiscite.

NOW THEREFORE, Council in meeting duly assembled enacts as follows.

1. That Council be empowered to install the required machinery, under competent engineering advice, to properly add fluorides to the Town water supply.
2. To pay for the cost of said equipment and engineering service as a first charge against the revenue of said water utility.
3. And the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby empowered to sign such cheques as may be severally required to meet these necessary expenditures, as are verified by Council.
