

TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE

BY-LAW 11A - 1971

A BY-LAW RESPECTING A PLEBISCITE OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO DETERMINE IF THE ELECTORS APPROVE FLUORIDATION OF THE COMMUNAL WATER SUPPLY.

WHEREAS the Public Health Act of Alberta provides that before a by-law providing authority for the fluoridation of the communal water supply is passed a plebiscite of the electors of the municipality shall be taken to determine if the electors approve fluoridation of the communal water supply; and

WHEREAS Council has given reading to a By-law providing for fluoridation of the Town of Slave Lake, water supply; and

WHEREAS it is considered and expedient to obtain the opinion of the electors on the following question; Do the Electors of the Town of Slave Lake approve of the fluoridation of the communal water supply? and to pass the by-law for the purpose of enabling the electors to vote on the said question.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The votes of the electors of the Town of Slave Lake shall be taken on the said question on the 13th day of October A.D., 1971, between the hours of 10 o'clock in the forenoon and 8 o'clock in the afternoon, at the following places:

2. Mrs. B. M. Lineton of the Town of Slave Lake is hereby appointed returning officer for the taking of the votes on the said question.
3. The returning officer shall sum up the votes for and against on the question at 9:00 PM on the 18th day of October A.D. 1971.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 4TH DAY OF AUGUST, A.D. 1971.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 4TH DAY OF AUGUST, A.D. 1971.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 4TH DAY OF AUGUST, A.D. 1971.
