

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING.

The Council of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled and under the authority and subject to the provisions of section 127 of The Municipal Government Act enacts as follows:

WHEREAS, in the opinion of this Council, it is deemed expedient and advisable to acquire certain lands hereinafter described to be used for the purpose of Public Works Building:

- (1) Therefore, under the provisions of The Municipal Government Act, The Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase or otherwise, that certain parcel of land more particularly described as follows:  
"All that portion of the South East quarter of section 36, township 72, range 6, West of the 5th. meridian, in the said province, taken for maintenance shop site shown shaded in red on road plan 2754 JY containing One & fifty hundredths (1.50) acres more or less. Excepting thereout-- five thousandths (0.005), of an acre more or less, as shown on plan 3065 JY.  
The land hereby described containing one & four hundred & ninety five thousandths (1.495) acres more or less.
- (2) The total purchase price is 6,000 dollars cash.
