

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR SUBDIVISION

The Council of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled and under the authority and subject to the provisions of section 127, subsection 7, of The Municipal Government Act enacts as follows:

WHEREAS, in the opinion of this Council, it is deemed expedient and advisable to acquire certain lands hereinafter described to be used for the purpose of subdivision and building sites for resale as needed.

(1) Therefore, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase or otherwise, that certain parcel of land more particularly described as follows: *

"Lot B containing 48.95 acres more or less in the Townsite of Slave Lake, in the said Province as shown on Subdivision Plan 613 N.Y. Excepting thereout:

- (A) 7.66 acres more or less subdivided under Plan 871 N.Y.
- (B) 8.83 acres more or less subdivided under Plan 3046 N.Y.

The land hereby described containing 32.46 acres more or less (N.E. - 36 - 72 - 6 - W5)
Reserving unto Her Majesty all Mines and Minerals.

(2) The total purchase price is twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00)/to be paid over three (3) years; interest of five (5%) per centum. Installments - 1971 - \$5,000.00, 1972 - \$10,000.00, 1973 - \$10,000.00.
