

B Y - L A W N . 0 . 1 6 4

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE FOR THE PURPOSE
OF CLOSING STREETS AND LANES IN SUB-DIVISION, PLAN
2875 N.Y.

WHEREAS, a request was received from property owners in sub-division, Plan 2875 N.Y., in the Town of Slave Lake, for the replot of this sub-division, and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that lanes and streets in the sub-division be closed.

WHEREAS a notice was published in the Edmonton Journal on August 22nd and August 24th, 1970, and posted in six locations within the Town of Slave Lake. The last of such publication being at least two weeks.

WHEREAS the Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the by-law.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Slave Lake, in accordance with Provincial Planning Act Section 33, duly assembled enacts as follows:

All of Sixth Avenue and Seventh Avenue
All of First B Street West
All of lane in Block twenty-one
Portion of First A Street West lying East of Lot 29, Block 20
All above as shown on registered Plan 2875 N.Y., in the
Town of Slave Lake, in the Province of Alberta, shall be closed
to all traffic as and from the date of the final passing of this
BY-LAW.
