

BY - LAW NO. 153

A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES
ON UNPAID TAXES.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Slave Lake deem it expedient to amend the Penalty structure authorized by By-Law No. 140 passed October 9th, 1969.

THEREFORE under the authority of and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Taxation Act 1967, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake hereby enacts:

1. That all taxes levied for any year shall be deemed to have been imposed and shall be deemed to have been due and payable on and from the first day of January of the then current year, unless otherwise expressly provided for in the by-law under which the taxes are directed to be levied.

2. That in the event of any taxes remaining unpaid as of August 1st in the year they are levied there shall be added by way of a penalty in amount of 2% (Two Per Cent) on the 2nd (second) day of August, and a further 4% (Four Per Cent) shall be added by way of a penalty on any taxes remaining unpaid after the first (1st) day of October of the year for which they were levied.

3. That a penalty of eight per cent (8%) shall be added to and shall form a part of any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31 of the year in which they were levied, and in each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid, except as exempted by Section 5.

4. This by-law shall replace and repeal By-Law 140 and shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing.

Read a third time and finally passed this 10th Day of December, 1969.
