

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE TO AUTHORIZE
THE TEMPORARY BORROWING OF MONEY.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town whenever it is authorized under any statute to borrow for any purpose, may borrow such sums as it deems necessary to carry out that purpose, until such time as the Grant therefore can be collected; and

WHEREAS the Council of the said Town deems it necessary to borrow the sum of Thirty-Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for payment of Contractors' Progress Payments until such time as the Grant from the Attorney Generals Department has been received; and

WHEREAS the amount it is deemed necessary to borrow does not exceed the limitation upon the borrowing powers of the Town:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED:

1. The Council of the Town of Slave Lake shall borrow from the Royal Bank of Canada, Slave Lake the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) until such time the Grant has been received from the Attorney Generals Department, and shall agree to pay interest on the sum so borrowed either in advance or at maturity, and in either case after maturity until paid, at the rate of not to exceed 8% (eight per centum) per annum.

2. The sum so borrowed shall be evidenced and secured by a promissory note or notes of the Town under its seal and duly attested by the signatures of the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer.

3. The Council of the Town of Slave Lake hereby pledge to the Royal Bank as security for the monies borrowed hereunder, the whole of the unpaid taxes and penalties and interest on taxes levied by the said Town in this current year, but the said Royal Bank shall not be restricted to the said taxes and penalties and interest for the payment of the money borrowed as aforesaid, or be bound to wait for repayment of such taxes and penalties and interest can be collected.

4. Nothing herein contained shall waive, pre-judicially affect or exclude any right, power, benefit or security, common law or otherwise, given to or implied in favor of the said Royal Bank of Canada, Slave Lake, Alberta.

5. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first time this 3rd day of April, 1968.

READ a second time this 3rd day of April, 1968.

READ a third time and finally passed this 3rd day of April, 1968.

DONE AND PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL WITH UNANIMOUS CONSENT OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT.
