

BY - LAW NO. 109.

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE FOR THE PURPOSE
OF IMPOSING CURFEW REGULATIONS.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY and pursuant to the provisions of
Section 306 (b) of the Town and Village Act, 1955, the Council
of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled hereby enact:

THAT, children sixteen years and under will not be
permitted on the Town Streets or in a public place
after the hour of 9:00 P.M. during the months of
September through June; and after the hour of 10:00 P.M.
during the months of July and August, unless accompanied
by a parent or guardian.

THAT, a public place shall mean any cafe, Theatre,
Railway depot or any other place to which the public
has access.

ANY child sixteen or under who is found on Town
streets or in a public place after the hours set out
as above, not accompanied by a parent or guardian shall
be presumed to be in such place with the knowledge
and consent of his parent or guardian.

That a parent or guardian who permits his child to
contravene this by-law is guilty of an offence and
liable to a penalty of not more than \$100.00 (one
hundred dollars) and in default of payment to a term of
imprisonment of not more than 60 days (Sixty days), not
inclusive of costs.


THAT by-law No. 5 is hereby rescinded and replaced.

THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect
on the final date of passing by Council.

Read a first time this 11th day of January, 1967.

Read a second time this 8th, day of February, 1967.

Read a third time and finally passed this 8th day of February, 1967.
