

BY-LAW NO. 118

A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE CANCELLATION OF UNCOLLECTABLE ARREARS OF TAXES.

WHEREAS, THERE APPEARS on the assessment and tax roll of the Town of Slave Lake, certain arrears of taxes, which the Council deem to be uncollectable, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient that such arrears of taxes be cancelled, and

WHEREAS, Section 394 of the Town and Village Act, being Chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955 authorizes a Council to pass a by-law, subject to the approval of the Minister to cancel arrears of taxes which are no longer secured by a charge against the land or other property and which are no longer collectible from the person taxes.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Slave Lake duly assembled enacts as follows:

THAT the arrears listed hereunder be cancelled for the reasons set out and that the Secretary-Treasurer be and she is hereby authorized to cancel same from the assessment and tax roll after this by-law has been finally passed and approved by the Minister.
