

A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A RETURNING OFFICER FOR THE PURPOSE OF TAKING A VOTE OF PROPRIETARY ELECTORS UPON BY-LAW NO. 105 AND FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE SAID VOTE.

WHEREAS THE COUNCIL has given first reading to By-law No.105 providing for the issuance of debentures of the Town of Slave Lake in the amount of \$15,748.00: ~~748.00~~

AND WHEREAS A petition has be received requiring a vote on the said by-law for the assent of the proprietary electors:

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SLAVE LAKE DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Rev. Dawson Beaver of the Town of Slave Lake is hereby appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of Taking the vote of proprietary electors of the Town By-law No. 105.
2. THAT, Wednesday the 15th day of February, 1967, between the hours of TEN o'clock in the forenoon and SEVEN o'clock in the afternoon, is hereby fixed as the day and hour for taking the vote of the proprietary electors on the said by-law.
3. That for the said purpose a poll shall be open at the Anglican Parish Hall in the said Town.
4. THAT the RETURNING OFFICER shall at the Town Office on ~~Wednesday~~ Thursday the 16th day of February, 1967 at 10:00 o'clock in the morning to sum up the votes given for and against the by-law and declare the result.
