

BY-LAW NO. 91

A BY-LAW PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTS ON CURRENT TAXES.

Under the powers conferred upon it by Section 339 of the Town and Village act, 1955, being Chapter 338 of the Statutes of Alberta, the Council of the Town of SLAVE LAKE, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


'That there shall be allowed on payment of taxes which become due and payable in the year in which payment is made, a discount of six (6) per centum (%), if payment is made on or before the second (2nd) day of July, 1966, and four (4) per centum (%), if payment is made on or before the second (2nd) day of August, 1966.'

Read a first time this 12 day of April, 1966.

Read a second time this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1966.

Read a third time this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1966, and finally passed.
